Having Reached A Climax At 29, I Was Dead (1965), Tadanori Yokoo

The poster's title, lettered at the bottom of the composition, is an acerbic reflection of the countercultural sentiments of Japanese youth of the time and their more general mistrust of postwar culture and politics. Yokoo himself was involved with the radical underground theater movement, designing posters and stage settings for assorted productions of one of its most avant-garde protagonists: Terayama Shūji. The radiating rising sun motif, both a symbol of wartime Japanese imperialism and an ornamental element from historic Japanese packaging design – notably on numerous matchboxes produced in the early 1900s – appears five separate times in the poster. Two visions of Mount Fuji, one of Japan's iconic national symbols, are printed in its top corners: one of these shows the Tokaido Shinkansen bullet train, which had debuted the year prior, speeding past an erupting Fuji-san in a depiction of speed, modernity, and power; the other is shrouded in a Sakura-pink mushroom cloud, signifying the country's very recent dystopian past. Another pink cloud is printed between the two mountains inside which sits the words 'Made in Japan'.

Underneath the images of Mount Fuji, the designer's name is inscribed in a historical American lettering style (similar to that found on Heinz ketchup labels) along a curved frame. From the centre of this dangles a morose illustration of Yokoo himself wearing a suit and tie, hanging from a noose with a rose in his hand. In the bottom corners of the poster are a photo of Yokoo at age one-and-a-half, and a teenage school photo overlaid with an illustration of a hand, its thumb clenched between the index and middle fingers – the symbol of lying in Japan, akin to crossed index and middle fingers in America and Europe. What I find endlessly fascinating about this poster, a visual obituary wreathed in sociopolitical critique, is that it also heralded Yokoo's very public debut. His use of retro-historical graphic elements was a firm and highly ornamental rebuttal of other Japanese designers' adoption of essentialist Bauhaus-inspired Western modernist methodologies, presenting here, a kind of 'death' of modernism.

A pigeon flew past, up into the high metal rafters. Its outline was barely visible against the darkness of the vaulted ceilings, but even in the low light, a dint of saturation could be seen on its chest. The bird must have found its way in through one of the large roll gate doors while a new vitrine was being transported into the archive.

The pigeon descended to the edge of one of the large glass cases, and slowly walked across its top, as if to better understand the dimensions of its surface. The case contained the mounted branch of a tree, which now made perfect sense as to why the pigeon must have instinctually flown towards it, hoping for a more appropriate perch. From the branch, suspended by nylon chord, was a round disc, 120mm in diameter, with a hole in the middle through which the chord passed. The disc hung motionless from the branch. The glass case that contained it bent around in 360 degrees, allowing for a perspective from all angles. The quality of the curved glass required constant attention, as any smudge or dust on its surface would hinder the effects of the light directed towards the CD-ROM.

A trace of emerald caught the light as the bird crossed the room, landing on a small upright case containing an ocean shell fixed on its end. The bird's coarse feet hovered just above the upper lip of the specimen, separated by a centimeter of glass. It appeared as though it was perched on the shell itself, its shadow cast across the swirling concave surface. This interference of the light directed

towards the shell rendered it practically invisible. With no regard for perspective, the pigeon lifted off with its shadow quickly passing over the case preserving an oil puddle.



In the dimmest corner of the room, the largest of the glass cases housed a small forest of rare begonias. This case was always being cleaned—once you made it to the far side of the display, dust

would begin to settle at the opposite end, catching tiny bits of light and preventing it from reaching the surface of the foliage. The plants were delicate and seemed to slow light down... if and

In a position opposite the male specimen, smudges and grease accumulated on the glass, traces left behind by observers trying to see what the female once saw. Marks that would need to be erased with soap and water.

Struggling to find an exit, the pigeon had caught its leg in a fold of fabric shrouding another vitrine. The fabric slid from the top, revealing a small mole, mounted on its side. With the curtain drawn, the specimen's fur reflected the light and shimmered. The interference of light was enough to send the bird off, perhaps moved by fear, out through a vent near the ceiling. The golden mole, always in the dark, was now an iridescent display with colors nearly constant from all directions.

Mood disorder is a group of diagnoses in the Diagnostic and Statistical Manual of Mental Disorders (DSM IV TR) classification system where a disturbance in the person's mood is hypothesized to be the main underlying feature.^[1] The classification is known as mood (affective) disorders in ICD 10.

English psychiatrist Henry Maudsley proposed an overarching category of affective disorder.^[2] The term was then replaced by mood disorder, as the latter term refers to the underlying or longitudinal emotional state,^[3] whereas the former refers to the external expression observed by others.^[1]

Two groups of mood disorders are broadly recognized; the division is based on whether a manic or hypomanic episode has ever been present. Thus, there are depressive disorders, of which the best-known and most researched is major depressive disorder (MDD) commonly called clinical depression or major depression, and bipolar disorder (BD), formerly known as manic depression and characterized by intermittent episodes of mania or hypomania, usually interlaced with depressive episodes. However, there are also psychiatric syndromes featuring less severe depression known as dysthymic disorder (similar to but milder than MDD) and cyclothymic disorder (similar to but milder than BD).^[4] Mood disorders may also be substance-induced or occur in response to a medical condition.

Teenagers who are prone to feelings of depression or sadness are more likely to participate in music, art, or drama as extracurricular activities rather than in other programs according to a new study.

Despite the "thrill of victory and the agony of defeat," teens who play sports were least likely to experience depressive symptoms according to the same study. Apparently teens who did both arts and sports were also depressed, however.
